

# Dominican Republic Missions Trip 2026

## Dates/ Itinerary

- June 22- Arrive in Dominican Republic
- June 23-25- In mission field
- June 26- Depart from Dominican Republic

## Total Cost

**\$1,200-1,500 (Cost will be finalized Feb. 1)**

- \$200 Non-refundable deposit with registration\*
- 50% remaining due March 15th
- 50% remaining due May 3rd

**This includes flights, housing, meals, travel insurance.** (Transportation included to/from airport included if we fly out of Orlando)

## Trip Meetings

Leading up to the trip we will have required team meetings, everyone is **required** to attend **3 out of 4** meetings.

- Have Bible study to prepare our hearts as a team
- Prepare all supplies, crafts, packing

## Registration

**Step 2:** On February 1<sup>st</sup>, official registration forms will be sent out if you are selected.

**Step 3:** Fill out official registration form and pay \$200 deposit to reserve your spot.

**A Note on Team Selection:** Our heart is to give as many people as possible the chance to experience this missions trip. Therefore, priority will be given to those who haven't attended this trip before and who call NWC their home church. If the trip fills up, don't worry—you'll be added to our waitlist and contacted if a spot opens up or if someone is unable to complete their registration.

## About Our Mission

We have been partnering with Craig and Joanna McClure for many years and it has been powerful to watch God multiply their efforts around the entire country of the Dominican Republic through their passion and intentional discipleship. During this week every year, we have the honor of serving and loving on people shoulder to shoulder with these incredible missionaries. In case you are wondering, this is a very family friendly trip and great for all ages to experience! This year we will be doing a Vacation Bible School in new villages as well as a construction project in the villages.

## Housing

Our teams stay at Score MTC in Juan Dolio. Each room is air-conditioned with a private bathroom. Unless otherwise arranged, all meals will be served at this facility, where SCORE employs cooks, housekeeping, and security guards. Most rooms have bunk beds or double beds.

**Families & Married Couples:** Will be roomed together.

**Individual Travelers:** Single travelers will be placed in gender-specific rooms (males with males, females with females) within our group's allotted block.

**Wi-Fi Access** - There is limited and regulated Wi-Fi access at the SCORE MTC.

## Meals

Meals provided will sometimes be American, but also include Dominican favorites. Breakfast and dinner will be at the Score MTC facility. Lunch will be packed and eaten in the field.

*Food Allergies* - there is generally plenty of food most everyone can eat. The kitchen cannot prepare specialty foods. However, you are welcome to bring supplemental items if needed. Teams will have access to a microwave.

## Health and Insurance

We want everyone to have a safe and impactful experience! Please keep in mind that the Dominican Republic is very hot and humid, and we will be spending most of our time outdoors in the sun.

The trip does involve a fair amount of walking, as our vans sometimes have to park a distance away from the villages we serve. While the work is labor-intensive, **don't let that discourage you**—we can make accommodations and find less strenuous roles for those who need them.

No vaccines required, but be up-to-date on standard shots (including tetanus).

Faith Ventures Insurance basic plan is included in your trip cost. You can see coverage by clicking on the link in your Managed Missions page after you register. Contact the SCORE home office if you would like to upgrade the coverage. Visit [CDC Travel Info](#) for CDC recommendations and a Healthy Travel Packing List before traveling.

## Cash to Bring

While most of your trip expenses are covered, you may want to bring extra cash for personal purchases. Shopping opportunities will be limited, but you might consider bringing money for the following:

- **Travel Meals:** Food and snacks at the airport.
- **Local Treats:** Coffee and desserts at a local shop we plan to visit.
- **Souvenirs:** Merch and keepsakes sold at the **SCORE** complex.

We recommend bringing \$150–\$200 in new, undamaged U.S. bills (nothing larger than \$20s) for personal expenses, activities, souvenirs, etc. While most places accept U.S. cash or credit cards, small bills are more convenient for local purchases. Missionaries can help you exchange U.S. Dollars for Pesos, if needed.

## Dress Code

We ask all participants to practice Biblical modesty by wearing non-revealing clothing. Please remember that we are guests in another country with different cultural standards and rules; out of respect for the community we are serving, we must honor these guidelines. In short: Dress to bless, not to impress.

### Women

- **Ministry & at SCORE** – Mid-thigh to longer/Bermuda style shorts and skirts, yoga pants and leggings with a long t-shirt covering the bottom section, sleeveless shirts and t-shirts. No midriffs showing.
- **Swimming** – Tankinis/one piece as long as they do not show the midriff or are cut high to expose the bottom section. Covering up is expected when not at the pool.

\*Undergarments must be covered at all times.

### Men

- **Ministry & MTC** – Shorts, pants, and t-shirts. Guys must wear shirts at all times except if swimming.
- **Swimming** – Swim shorts are to be worn, no speedos. Covering up is expected when not at the pool. Tank tops are fine.
